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To Parent, Teacher & Employee Organizations:

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires that all educational facilities be inspected for asbestos – containing materials and develop a remedial plan of action on or before May 9, 1989. In addition, each educational facility shall reassess all identified asbestos – containing materials or materials assumed to be asbestos, at least once every six months (Periodic Surveillance) and re-inspect those facilities at least once every three years (Tri-annual Re-inspection)

The Mt. Laurel Twp. Board of Education is in compliance with these requirements. The most recent Tri-annual Re-inspection was performed in June of 2023. “Periodic Surveillance” inspections are performed every June and December unless a Tri-annual re-inspection is due. The latest “Periodic Surveillance” took place in June 2024, with the next one scheduled for December 2024.

Following each inspection, appropriate remedial actions are recommended to the Board of Education by an accredited Asbestos Management Planner. The remedial plans of action and recommended schedules for implementation (Asbestos Management Plans) are available for review at the Mt. Laurel Board of Education Administrative Office, as well as in each school office.

We will continue to keep you informed of our AHERA compliance.
