Lilah Penhorwood is working to raise awareness of human trafficking. Ohio ranks in the top 5 states for trafficking reports, and as Johnstown prepares for growth, Lilah wants to ensure that Johnstown addresses the risk for increased trafficking in the community. She seeks to help the community build a partnership with local resources, and she arranged for Jami Gray from the organization Freedom Collective (formerly Out of Darkness) to speak to Johnstown City Council in an effort to start this outreach.

Alexis Diehl has continued her outreach with middle school female athletes. She is passionate about helping young women recognize the barriers that may exist and that inhibit confidence for female athletes, and she wants to provide a level of mentorship to middle school young women to address these barriers head-on.

Frieda Zirille wants to ensure community support for all women who choose to give birth, and to help, she curated resources for women who may need additional support during pregnancy. She is also collaborating with Esther's Place of Grace in Newark on a donations of baby layettes to support the pregnant women who seek assistance from the agency.
