Transportation

Food Service

All electronic payments for food service must be made through the Meal Magic Family Portal and will be reflected in student accounts within 15 minutes. We encourage creation of a Meal Magic account, which allows you to view balances, see account and purchase histories, make deposits, transfer money among family members and set parental controls.
