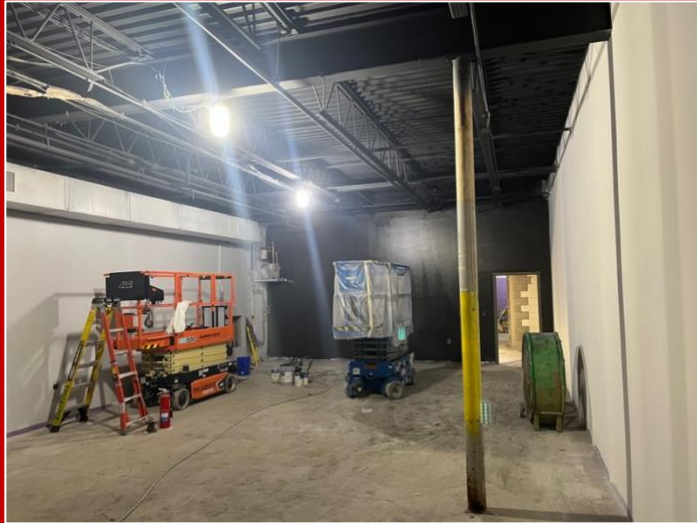
## Brutus Buckeye Visits JMS
