Johnstown-Monroe Buys City Administration Site



After months of negotiations, joint strategy sessions, and land-use and planning discussions, the City of Johnstown and Johnstown-Monroe School District on Monday, Feb. 10, 2025, agreed to the sale of the City's land and office building at 599 S. Main St. to the school district for \$1.2 million.

While J-M will initially re-fit and use a portion of the building for athletic purposes, the District has also agreed to a multi-year lease that will allow some city and police functions to continue to operate from the Main Street site while City Administration and City Council explore other future sites.

As one city leader put it, the agreement is indeed a "historic" one for our community.
