Volunteer Clearances Required

In order to volunteer within the school, the district requires you to have the following clearances on file. You must also be a FAEPTA member to do any work with the PTA.

PA CHILD ABUSE HISTORY (FREE TO VOLUNTEERS-use 'SCHOOL' for Purpose of Clearance)

- 1. Go to https://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis/public/home
- 2. Select Create Individual Account
- 3. Click Next, fill in information and follow through the prompts on the following screens
- 4. Once submitted, wait for an email back saying it is complete (takes a couple days). You will need to log back into the website to access the results to print.

PA CRIMINAL RECORD HISTORY (FREE TO VOLUNTEERS)

- 1. Go to https://epatch.pa.gov/home
- 2. Click New VOLUNTEER Record Check
- 3. Read, check the box, then click Accept
- 4. Enter all the necessary information and follow through the prompts
- 5. Print out your results

FBI FEDERAL CRIMINAL HISTORY/FINGERPRINTS (\$25)

- 1. Go to https://uenroll.identogo.com/
- 2. Enter the service code: 1KG6XN
- 3. Select Schedule or Manage Appointment
- 4. Enter all the necessary information and follow through the prompts
- 5. At the end, it will show you a list of locations and their appointment availability or you can look up the closest location for you and just do a walk in.
